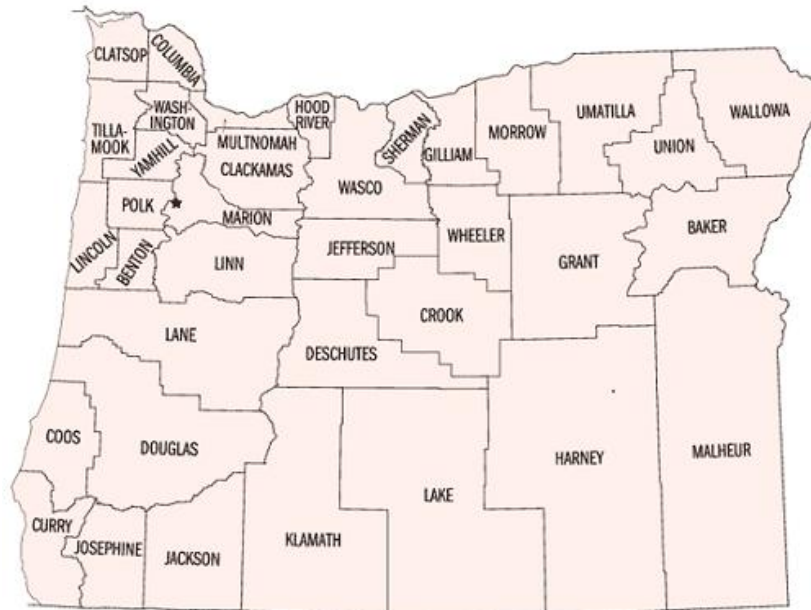


Oregon County Sheriff's Dept. CHL Web Pages

The names of the Oregon Counties below are links to that counties Sheriff CHL issuing information webpage. Oregon Statute allows Oregon Sheriffs to issue permits on a "May Issue" basis to residents of boarder states of Oregon. This would be California, Idaho, Nevada and Washington. Most Oregon Sheriffs will only issue to residents of their county. Some will issue to only one or two neighboring states and many require the person to own property, business or work in their county. Handgunlaw.us keeps hearing of some Sheriffs who will issue to anyone from any of the border states who meets the same requirement as their residents. You will have to contact the sheriffs or ask questions on a state specific firearms forum like [Pacific Northwest Guns](#) who may be able to point you in the right sheriff who will issue to a non-resident.
